

## Automotive Certification Programme (ACP)

### 1. What is the Automotive Certification Programme (ACP)?

The Automotive Certification Programme (ACP) is an initiative by MARii designed to recognise individuals in the automotive industry who demonstrate competency based on the National Occupational Skills Standards (NOSS). It validates skills through participants' work experience and achievements.

### 2. What is the main objective of the ACP Programme?

The programme aims to formally recognise and upskill automotive professionals, ensuring they meet industry standards. It also provides opportunities for participants to enhance their knowledge through structured training aligned with current technologies and practices.

### 3. Who is eligible to apply for the ACP Programme?

- i. The ACP Programme is targeted at:
- ii. Malaysian citizens
- iii. Individuals with at least 3 years of continuous working experience in the automotive industry
- iv. Automotive workers, technicians, and business owners seeking formal certification

### 4. What certification do participants receive under ACP?

Participants who successfully complete the programme will be awarded the Sijil Kemahiran Malaysia (SKM), typically at Level 3, based on their prior work experience and demonstrated competencies.
